**TOPIC:**                      An observed relationship between vestibular function and auditory thresholds in aircraft maintenance workers

We have observed in a study population with noise induced hearing loss (n=1538) that hearing loss in the low frequencies (500 - 3000 Hz) has a negative relationship with performance in a test of balance.
